TYPES OF Aquatic Ecosystem

1) Marine Ecosystem (Saltwater):



A Marine Ecosystem is a type of aquatic ecosystem found in saltwater environment, primarily in the Oceans and sea. It encompasses a variety of habitats and species that interact with each other and their physical surroundings.

Types of Marine Ecosystem:

1) Open Ocean (Pelagic Zone):

- The largest habitat on earth, covering about 70% of the planet's surface. Includes plankton, fish, whales and sharks.

2) Deep - Sea Ecosystem:

Found in abyssal plains and trenches at extreme depths. Home to unique species adapted to high pressure, low light, and cold temperature eg:- angelfish, bioluminescent,

2. Explain the steps involved in Standard Costing system.

Step 1:-

Determination of Cost centre. The Cost centre is necessary for fixing costs & fixation of responsibility. In the manufacturing concern, Cost centres are created acc^o to the no. of products produced & the no. of sections, departments & divisions are involved in the production process.

A cost centre relating to a person is called personal cost centre and a cost centre relating to products & equipment is called impersonal cost centre.

Step 2:-

Classification of A/c's.

The costs are incurring at various stages of production process, these costs should be recorded properly for accurate calcⁿ of total costs incurred. Hence, there is a need of classification of accounts for cost control under std. costing system.

Step 3:- Codification of A/c's.

The different accounts can be codified & different symbols can be used to facilitate

speedy collection, communication and reporting, the following codes can be used for elements of cost.

Codes & elements of Cost.

000-100 Direct materials

101-150 Indirect materials

151-200 Direct labour

201-250 Indirect labour

251-300 Direct exp^s

301-400 factory O.H.

401-500 office & administration O.H.

501-600 - selling & distribution O.H.

4. Setting of standards:-

Standard is an ideal which is anticipated & can be attained over a future period of time, normally is next working year. The success of standard costing system is based on genuineness, reliability & acceptance of standards.

5. Establishing std costs:-

Std cost are established for each element of cost separately. Generally, elements of cost is grouped as material, labour & O.H.

6. Preparing std cost card & standard cost sheet:-

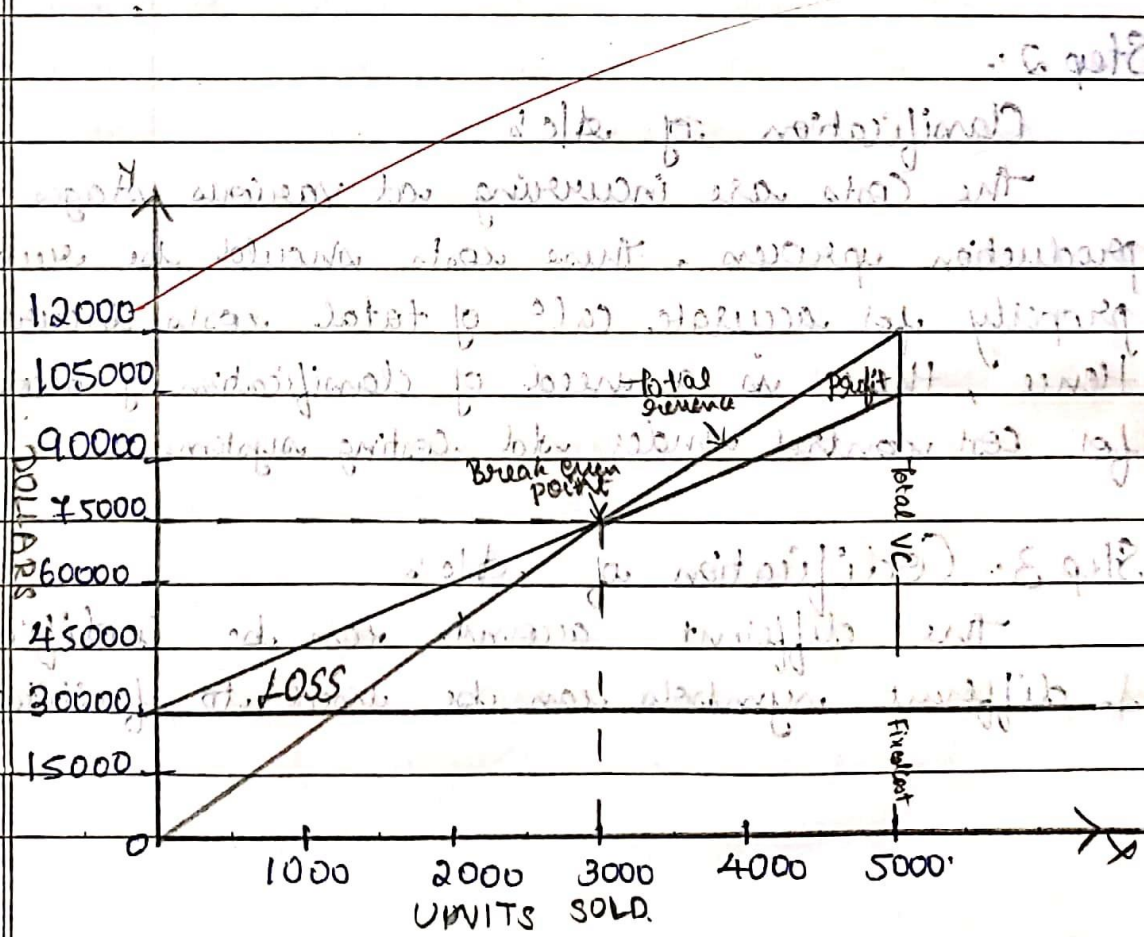
Std cost card or std cost sheet is prepared separately for product wise or process wise.

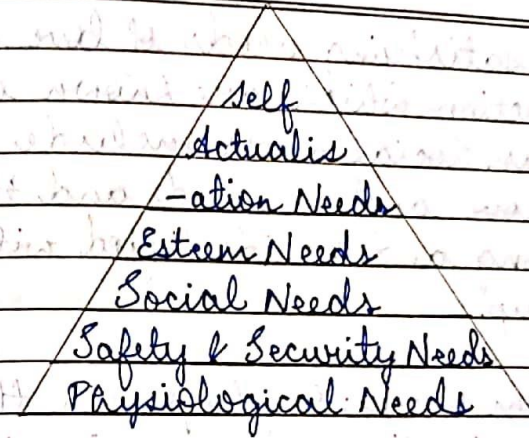
incentives for achieving the desired goals. The incentives may be in the shape of more pay, promotion and recognition of work.

- 1) Maslow's Need Hierarchy: This theory was developed by Abraham Maslow, an eminent psychologist and has received more attention from managers than any other theory of motivation. He has classified human needs in logical convenient way that has an important motivation implication for managers.

- a) Physiological Needs: These are most basic needs including food, shelter & clothing. These needs are most powerful motivators as individual cannot survive without them.
- b) Safety Needs: After the satisfaction of physical needs to a relative extent, one feels concerned about safety from future uncertainty, enemies and other threats. These are essentially needs of self-preservation.
- c) Social Needs: After having secured satisfaction for physical needs and protection for future, one focuses next

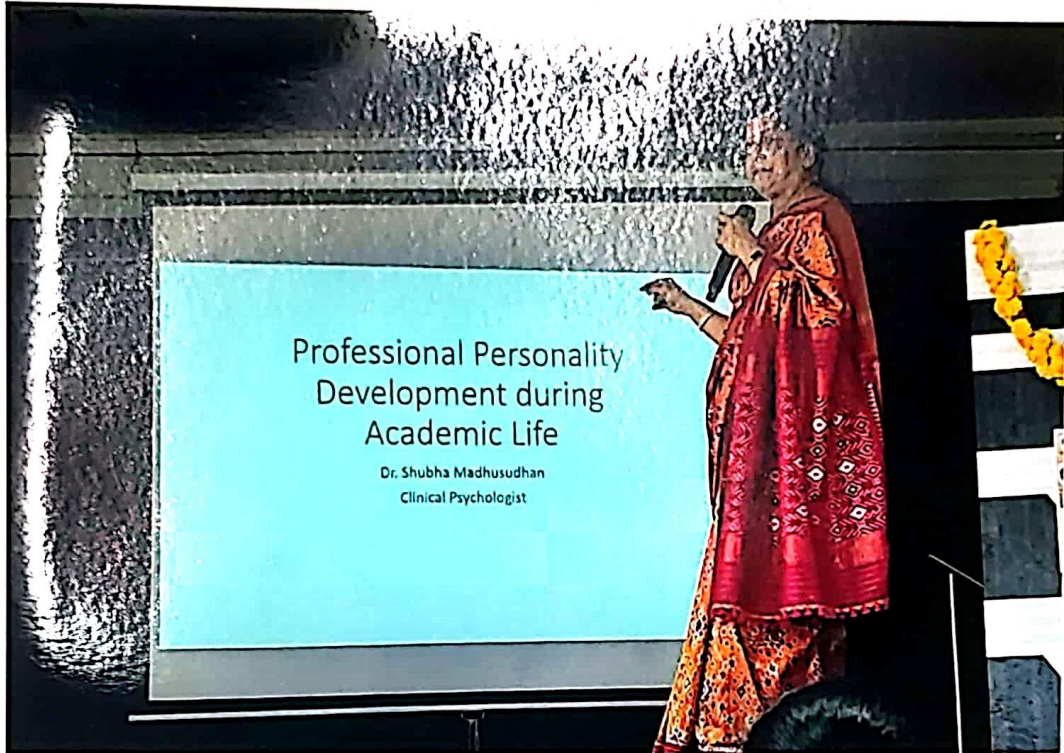


