## Key programs include:

- **Institutional Mission**: Our mission is to prepare students to be value-conscious with the right attitude for a healthy society. Ethics are imparted through various programs.
- **Daily Assembly and Prayer**: Every day begins with an assembly and a daily prayer featuring hymns from the Vedas, followed by the National Anthem, creating a sacred start to the day.
- VVSFGC Bank and Vardhini Stores: The college provides practical exposure through internship programs and the operation of VVSFGC Bank and Vardhini Stores, offering students hands-on experience in management and entrepreneurship.
- **Samskruthi**: This program introduces students to Indian culture and instils moral values through talks, discourses, and Gamakas.

- Art Appreciation Club: Founded two decades ago, this club organizes events to introduce students to various art forms through lectures and demo sessions. It has inspired many students to pursue careers in art and literature.
- **Personality Development Program (PDP)**: A three-day residential camp for about 50 selected students, the program focuses on communication skills, Human Resource Management, team building, and other life skills. - **Students' Association**: Student volunteers under this association organize all the college programs, honing their event management skills and fostering teamwork.
- National Service Scheme (NSS): NSS activities promote the development of social values, environmental awareness, and national consciousness among students.
- **Business Lab and Skill Development Centre**: This centre provides practical training in subjects taught throughout the course.
- **Industrial Visits**: These visits expose students to real-world industries, helping them understand the working environment and industrial practices.
- **Student Research Projects**: These projects encourage a research-driven mindset. The annual interclass competition, 'Anveshana', fosters research skills. Each year, a specific topic is chosen, and students from different classes explore sub-topics through various presentation formats, including PowerPoint, models, charts, skits, and role plays.
- Kaladarshini: An interclass cultural competition where students showcase their talents in dance, drama, and other art forms. Each class is allotted one hour to perform, and the year's theme must be incorporated into at least two performances. Judged by renowned celebrities in music, dance, and drama, the event evaluates aspects such as time management, stage arrangement, and invitation design.
- Food Fest: An annual event where students demonstrate their culinary talents.
