National Youth Day Celebration






International Women's Day Celebration

Report of the Annual Special Camp

Good afternoon to one and all present here. Respected dignitaries on the dais and all my fellow volunteers seated here, I, Usha C., NSS Co-ordinator, from 3rd year B. Com, stand before you all to read the NSS Annual Special Camp 2024-25 Report.

The annual NSS Special Camp was conducted from 09/04/2025 – 15/04/2025. The main motive of the camp was to inculcate the service motive and to enhance our knowledge with the practical experiences of life.

The camp started on 09/04/2025, Wednesday, where all the students assembled in college at 12:30 pm and we departed to our Nelamangala Campus, PRAKRUTHIDHAMA, T-Begur. We reached by 2:45 pm where a delicious snack was waiting for us. We took a break to freshen up and then assembled in the Bhajan hall for pooja and some games and then we were split into groups of 5 to work together throughout the entire camp. 


