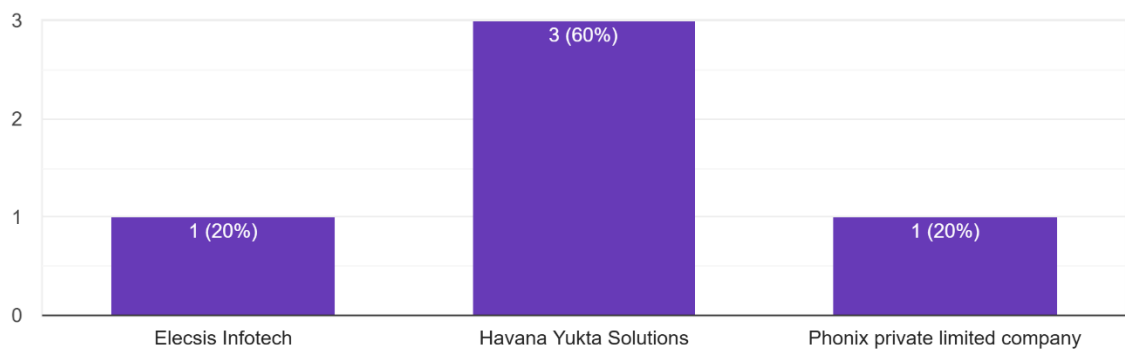

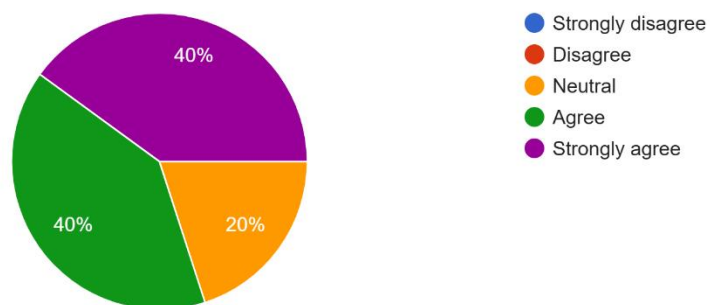

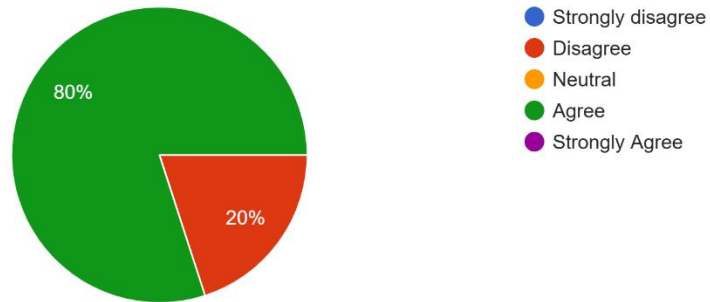

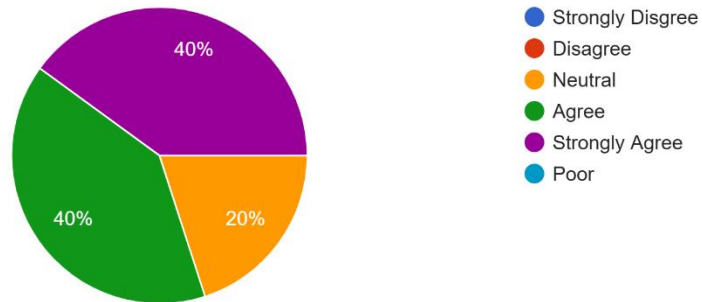

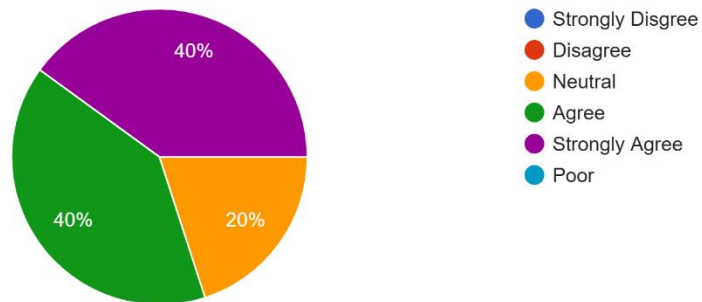

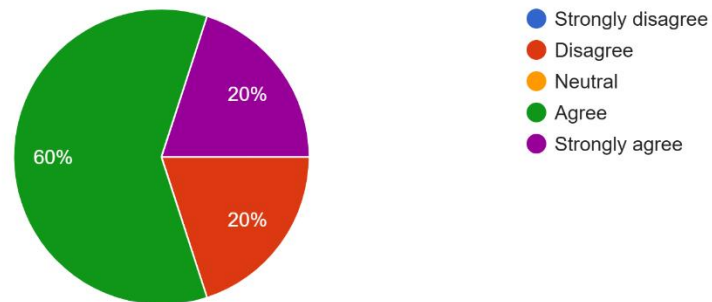

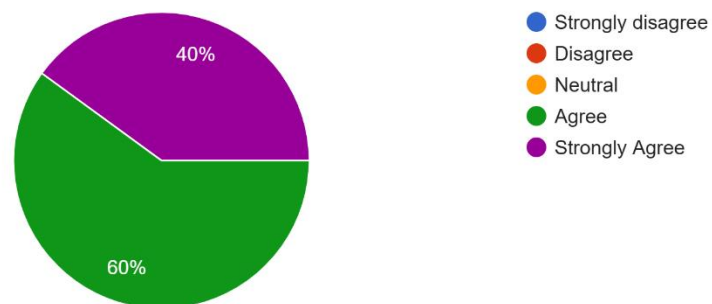

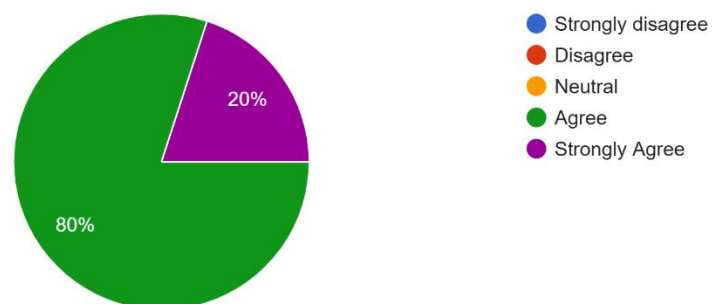

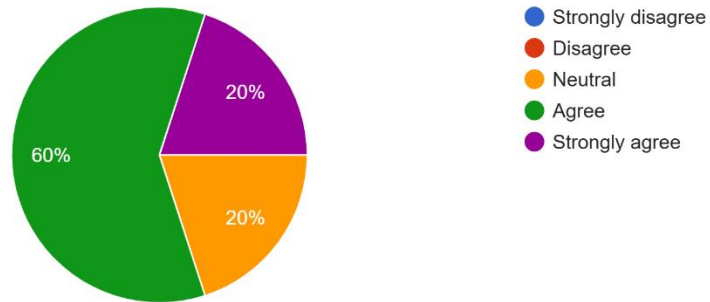

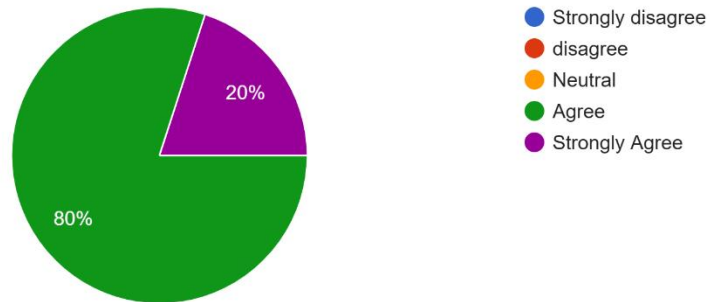

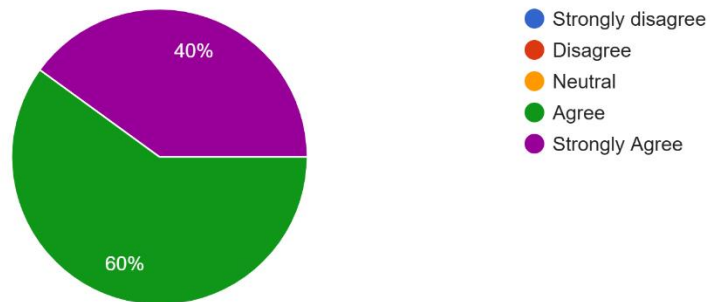

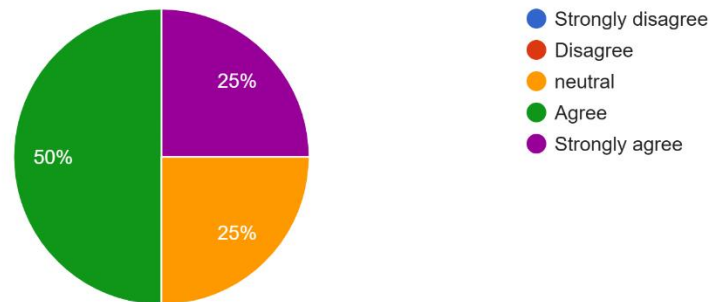

1. Respondent Profile

2. Feedback Overview

Overall, the feedback is highly positive, with most employers selecting "Agree" or "Strongly Agree" across all curriculum-related categories.

Key Strengths (High Agreement):

- **Syllabus Value:** 100% of respondents agreed or strongly agreed that the syllabus adds learning values (skills, concepts, and analytical abilities).
- **Industry Relevance:** 100% agreed or strongly agreed that the industry-related courses are sufficient.
- **Student Proficiency:** All employers (100%) were satisfied with the proficiency of the students working with them.
