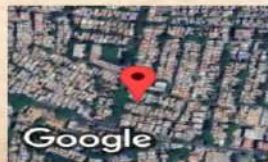

## **National Youth Day Celebration**

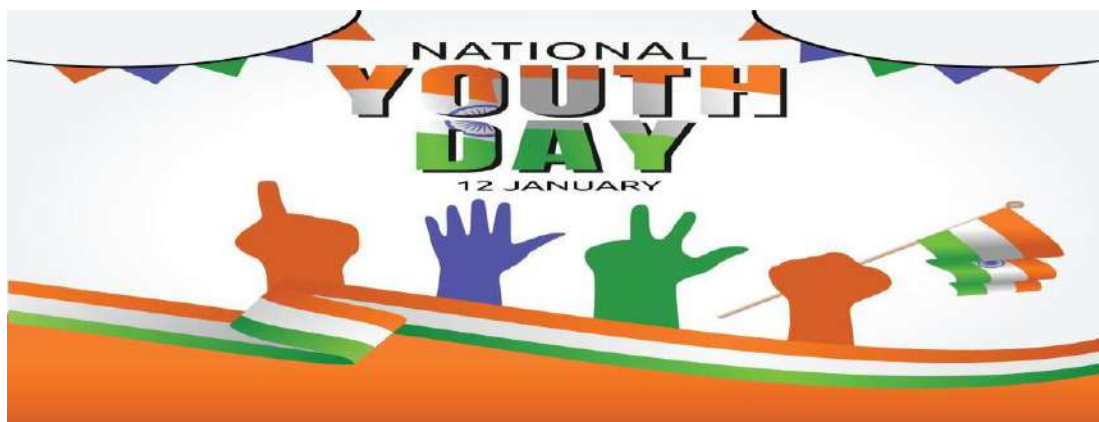

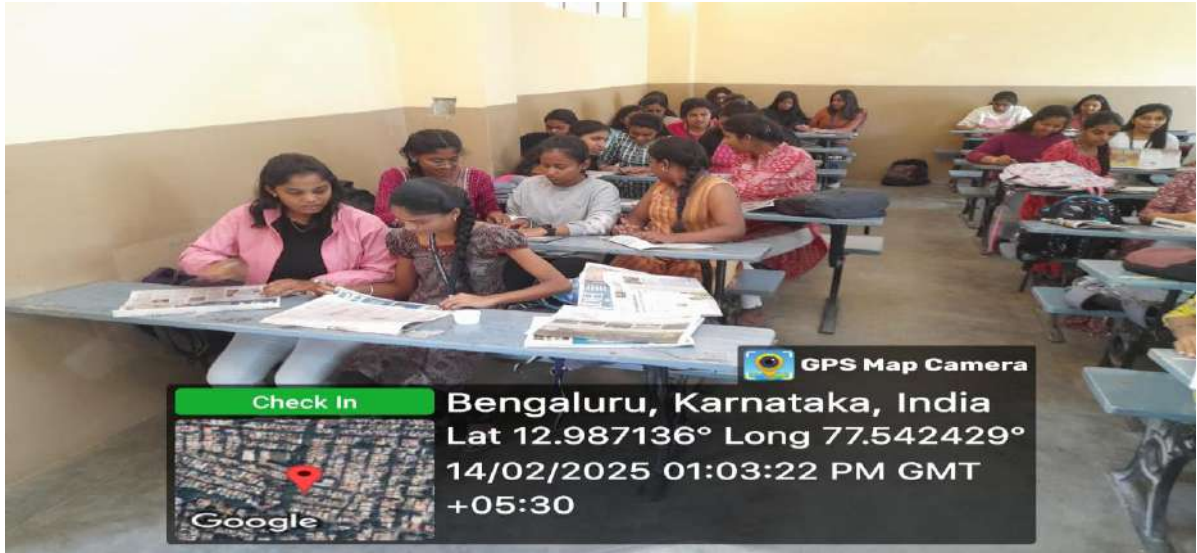

## **Report of the Annual Special Camp**

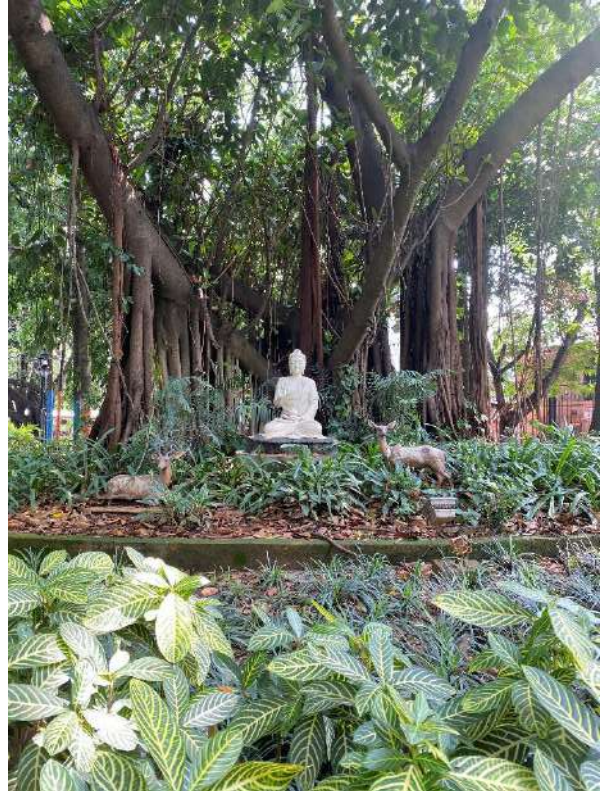
